Congratulations to all our competitors, we have never had such a good month for qualifying people to the next grade of competition. Its great to have you all so interested and getting us out onto the regional stage.

We have had a super month for competitions at Severn TC. Our first competition was the Grade D qualifier at Tamworth on 16 October. This has just the current regional grade D age groups for trampoline, regional D DMT and GMPD qualification. The smaller competition is designed to show case the talent in West Midlands that is aspiring to qualify for the national circuit of competitions which takes place at the regional galas. Amy Trow won the grade D over 19 girls trampoline competition and qualified to the National C competitions. This is a big first for Severn TC and I am so proud on Amy for keeping a positive attitude on the day. Amy also won the grade D over 15 girls DMT competition. Caitly Higgins won the grade D under 15 girls DMT competition and Stacey Blakeway was third.





Our second competition was the grade I to E assessment day in Birmingham. - We had one of our largest entries, 16 in total with 7 also entering the DMT competition so we have 23 results.*
- In trampolining we had one individual first place and three seconds and a team second. Additionally we had one qualification to the next grade and four new competitors.*
- In DMT we provided 7 of the overall 18 entries and dominated the runway in the under 15 competition with 5 of the 9 competitors. We came away with two individual second places, a third and team first.*

Well done to everyone involved with a special mention for Sky for getting trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd all in one day, Louisa who finished first in her groups and has chosen to move to the next grade, and to our teams in DMT under 15 girls and boys for a team first place and 1 under 11 boys for securing team second place.

These are great training days for competitors and an opportunity for people who are not sure whether they want to compete to just see what the process is like.
